Directions to St. John's Catholic Church (1055 Hughes Rd., Madison, Alabama 35758): **From Huntsville**, take I-565 West, and exit on to Madison Blvd (Exit #13). Go right on Hughes Rd., and follow approximately 4 miles. Cross over Old Madison Pike and Gillespie Rd., and look for the Church on the right after passing the Cliff's Cove Community. You'll see the church on the hill, and should take the second driveway. Proceed to the first parking lot in front of the property, next to the field in front of the Church. You'll see us set up there, and ready to welcome you! If you are coming from Highway 72 (University Dr.), come into Madison and take a left on to Hughes Rd. Follow for two miles or so, and the Church entrance will be on your left, just after the Mandolin Community (across from Trinity Baptist Church).
